The Arizona Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) requires the information above. The license plate will only be issued for a currently registered vehicle, registered or leased in the applicant's name. If leased and not registered in the applicant's name, a document showing the applicant as lessee is required.

The annual fee for this special plate is \$25.00 per year (\$27.40 for the initial year). The initial year and each year you renew your wildlife conservation license plate the MVD will retain eight dollars of the fee for the purposes of administering the program and **seventeen dollars is a donation to the Wildlife Conservation Council for habitat projects, education, communication and administration.**

An organizational special plate may not be issued to at least the following: commercial vehicle, trailer, travel trailer, polaris, alternative fuel vehicle, or motorcycles.

Wildlife Conservation Arizona State License Plate Frequently Asked Questions

Where can I get a Wildlife Conservation license plate? Contact the Wildlife Conservation Council (WCC) at 602-712-9822 or a WCC member club for an application. You cannot request an application directly from the Motor Vehicle Division (MVD). Once you have completed your application you need to send it to the WCC, and we will submit your application directly to the MVD.

How much does the Wildlife Conservation license plate cost? \$27.40 Initial fee (payable to the Motor Vehicle Division). **\$17 is returned to the WCC for habitat projects, education, communication, and administration** (WCC member clubs will be eligible for these funds). The MVD retains \$8 for license plate administration and \$2.40 for postage and handling. Future license plate renewal years will be \$25.

Can I personalize my Wildlife Conservation license plate? No, you are not able to personalize your Wildlife Conservation license plate. The license plate numbers will be assigned randomly.

What if my license plate registration has not expired? MVD will send you your Wildlife Conservation license plate with your current registration dates on the plate. MVD is not able to prorate your fee for the months that you have remaining on your registration.

How will I renew my Wildlife Conservation license plate? MVD will send you a license renewal in the mail. Be sure to indicate that you want to renew the Wildlife Conservation license plate with a \$25 annual renewal fee in addition to your regular registration fees. Each year that you renew your Wildlife Conservation license plate WCC will continue to receive your \$17 donation.

Can I purchase more than one Wildlife Conservation license plate? Yes, you can purchase a plate for all cars registered in your name. Conservation plates are not available for alternative fuel vehicles, trailers, travel trailers, commercial vehicles, vehicles that are not leased in your name, Polaris, or motorcycles.

Can I transfer my plate to my next car? Yes

Who do I make my check payable to? Make your check payable to Motor Vehicle Division for \$27.50.

Where do I send my application and check? Mail your application directly to the Wildlife Conservation Council at PO Box 13116, Phoenix, AZ 85002-3116. **Do not mail your application directly to the MVD** (they will not accept the application and it will be sent back to you).
